Associated Student Government

The Associated Student Government (ASG) at the University of Arkansas is a student-led organization that acts as an organized voice for all students and effectively represents them in the University's policy and decision-making. ASG is composed of three branches: Executive, Legislative, and Judicial. The Executive Branch is comprised of the President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and the Executive Cabinet. The Legislative Branch includes the Student Senate, Legislative Officers, and Legislative Committees. The Judicial Branch is made up of the nine-seat ASG Judiciary. All three branches work together to improve every aspect of student life here on the University of Arkansas campus while promoting citizenship on campus and in the greater community.

ASG Judiciary

The ASG Judiciary (ASGJ) is composed of nine justices who serve for one full academic year. They are appointed by the President and approved by the Senate. Once the justices are confirmed, the Chief Justice is elected from within its members. The ASGJ has two main functions. First of all, they are responsible for interpretation of the ASG Constitution, Code, and all legislation that is passed through the Senate. They are also responsible for hearing all misconduct cases that occur within ASG.
