Associated Student Government

The Associated Student Government (ASG) at the University of Arkansas is a student-led organization that acts as an organized voice for all students and effectively represents them in the University's policy and decision-making. ASG is composed of three branches: Executive, Legislative, and Judicial. The Executive Branch is comprised of the President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and the Executive Cabinet. The Legislative Branch includes the Student Senate, Legislative Officers, and Legislative Committees. The Judicial Branch is made up of the nine-seat ASG Judiciary. All three branches work together to improve every aspect of student life here on the University of Arkansas campus while promoting citizenship on campus and in the greater community.

ASG Executive Cabinet

The Executive Cabinet works closely with the student body on a wide range of issues. Each cabinet member is selected to work with a certain aspect of campus life. Cabinet chairs must be organized and feel comfortable speaking in front of groups of peers or administrators. They are expected to work closely with the Executives, the Senate and other chair positions to make ASG as effective as possible. Each position meets weekly with an ASG Executive to discuss ideas or projects and to make sure all of the different areas focus on one vision for the student body: to connect them to campus. Below, please find a list of the cabinet positions along with a brief description of that position's overall objective.

- **Chief of Staff** – overall coordinator of all cabinet positions; responsible for oversight and effective communication within the cabinet and between the cabinet and ASG Executives and ASG Senate
- **Academic Affairs** – responsible for issues related to the academic aspects of campus; possible concentrations could be teacher evaluations, textbook rentals, or classroom procedures
- **Athletic Relations** – responsible for student relations with the athletic department; specific projects include Homecoming, Rolling with the Razorbacks, and King of the Hill
- **Philanthropy** – responsible for student led activities that give back to the greater community and making students aware of problems in community and providing active ways to help
- **Special Events** – responsible for ASG special events throughout the year; current special events include ASG Friday Night Live and the Martin Luther King, Jr. vigil, however more will be added
- **Freshman Experience** – responsible for connecting incoming freshmen to the entire student body and campus; areas of responsibility will include a freshmen leadership class in the coming fall
- **Campus Life, Safety, and Parking** – responsible for the overall campus atmosphere, the safety of the students on campus, and the parking and transit issues on campus, including the Safe Ride Program
- **Liaison to Faculty and Staff Senate** – works as a liaison between ASG and Faculty and Staff Senate to ensure to all bodies are communicating effectively, promoting work on similar objectives
- **External Relations**- Be responsible for relations outside of campus and help maintaining the Arkansas Students Association and attend its meetings. He should also work to build relationships with others in the state who contribute to the students on campus, including state officials and board members.
- **Constituent Relations**- Promote ASG to wide variety of groups on campus. Set up meetings throughout the year with different RSO's and other groups to find out how ASG can benefit them. Work on coordinating suggestion booths around campus.
- **Assistant Secretary** – assistant to current Secretary Quinten Whiteside to assist with ASG communication outlets such as the ASG newsletter, collaboration with the Traveler, and important advertising
- **Assistant Treasurer** – assistant to current Treasurer Ryan Marsh to assist with RSO Appropriations and to help maintain the ASG Executive and Senate budgets
