Associated Student Government

The Associated Student Government (ASG) at the University of Arkansas is a student-led organization that acts as an organized voice for all students and effectively represents them in the University's policy and decision-making. ASG is composed of three branches: Executive, Legislative, and Judicial. The Executive Branch is comprised of the President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and the Executive Cabinet. The Legislative Branch includes the Student Senate, Legislative Officers, and Legislative Committees. The Judicial Branch is made up of the nine-seat ASG Judiciary. All three branches work together to improve every aspect of student life here on the University of Arkansas campus while promoting citizenship on campus and in the greater community.

Fresh H.O.G.S. Program

Fresh H.O.G.S. (Freshmen Helping Our Government Succeed) is a year-long program focused on educating first-year students on student government. Students will learn how the role of ASG works in representing student needs throughout campus. They will also learn about the make-up of ASG and the roles each position play in making our student government as effective as possible. The goal of this program is to get first-year students active on-campus, providing better-educated student leaders and continuity within ASG. The program is set-up with a combination of guest speakers, information sessions, and hands-on experience, culminating in a large-scale project during the spring semester. Participants in this program will also participate in Emerging Leaders in the spring semester. The selected students will meet five times a semester on Wednesday nights between 6:00pm and 7:30pm starting on September 20, 2006.
