

Honors Film Association Constitution

2007-2008

Article I. Title and Objectives

- Sec. 1. A Registered Student Organization (RSO) shall exist at the University of Arkansas in Fayetteville according to the following Constitution.
- Sec. 2. This RSO shall be called the Honors Film Association (HFA).
- Sec. 3. The overall purpose of this RSO shall be to advance the interest in film and other cinematic arts on the campus of the University of Arkansas.
- Sec. 4. The express purpose for the establishment of this RSO is to ensure efficiency, fluidity and success in the planning and implementation of the Honors Film Symposia, with particular attention being paid to the Indigenous People's Day Observance and Native American Symposium, which are conducted fall semester.

Article II. Membership

- Sec. 1. As an RSO, HFA shall have membership open indiscriminately to all students at the University of Arkansas.
- Sec. 2. Because this RSO will work in conjunction with honors students enrolled in film lecture, these students will have automatic membership in this RSO at the beginning of the class.

Article III. Officers and Elections

- Sec. 1. All students, including freshmen, may run to become an officer of the Council of HFA.
- Sec. 2. Elections for the Council shall be held at the beginning of each academic year, preferably after the Honors Film Lecture class has had a chance to meet.
- Sec. 3. There shall be six (6) council positions held by students in the Honors Film Association.
- Sec. 4. If possible, at least one of the council positions shall be reserved for a returning student who has had experience in the organization.
- Sec. 5. A Staff Advisor designated by the Communications Department will also serve on the Council.
- Sec. 6. Elected officers for this organization will include a president, vice president, secretary, assistant secretary, treasurer, and assistant treasurer.

Article IV. Regular Meetings

- Sec. 1. The Honors Film Association shall hold regular meetings.
- Sec. 2. The purpose of the meetings will be to plan and execute actions necessary to the implementation of the Honors Film Symposium.

Article V. Duties of Council Officers

- Sec. 1. The Council will arrange to meet whenever an issue concerning the future of the organization arises.
- Sec. 2. The Council will meet at least once every semester.
- Sec. 3. The six elected Council officers will have equal powers and responsibilities as well as equal voting rights.

Sec. 4. The main duty of the Council will be to manage RSO finances concerning HFA.

Article VI. Honors Film Symposium

Sec. 1. The Honors Film Symposium shall be held one semester during the academic year.

Sec. 2. The overall purpose of the Honors Film symposium is to educate the general public on the different histories and aspects of film.

Sec. 3. The primary responsibilities in the implementation of the symposium will fall in the hands of the students enrolled in Honors Film Lecture.
